Dear Shareholder

Termination of LAM Sun Global ZyFin India Sovereign Enterprise Bond UCITS ETF

We are writing to you as a Shareholder in the Fund. The purpose of this letter is to notify you of the Company's intention to terminate the Fund.

We wish to notify you that, in accordance with Article 12.1 (d) of the Articles and further to a recommendation from ZyFin Capital Limited, the Company's investment advisor, the board of directors of the Company (the “**Board**”) has resolved to terminate the Fund and redeem all Shares in issue in it with effect from **October 31, 2017** (the “**Termination Date**”).

This recommendation was made as the Net Asset Value of the Fund is below the level specified in the Prospectus, such that the Fund is not viable as a going concern. The Board therefore believe that it is in the best interests of the Shareholders of the Fund to terminate it.

Shareholders may request that their Shares be redeemed in respect of any Dealing Day up to **October 23, 2017** (the “**Final Dealing Date**”) in accordance with the terms of the Prospectus and any Shares redeemed prior to or on the Final Dealing Date will be redeemed at the Net Asset Value per Share on the relevant Dealing Day.

Shares in respect of which no redemption request is received up to the Final Dealing Date will automatically be redeemed on the Termination Date at the Net Asset Value per Share on the Termination Date and no further action is required from you in order for Shares to be redeemed in this way. No redemption or transfer requests from Shareholders will be accepted after the Final Dealing

Day and redemption proceeds in respect of Shares redeemed on the Termination Date will be paid to the Shareholders on record as of the Final Dealing Date.

Lemanik Asset Management SA, Dublin Branch, the Company's investment manager ("**Lemanik**") will endeavour to keep the Fund invested according to its investment objective and policies until the Termination Date but, that redemption requests received prior to that day render this impractical, Lemanik may be forced to convert all of the Fund's investments to cash.

Please contact your Lemanik representative if you require additional information or would like to have your Shares redeemed or transferred in advance of the Final Dealing Date.
